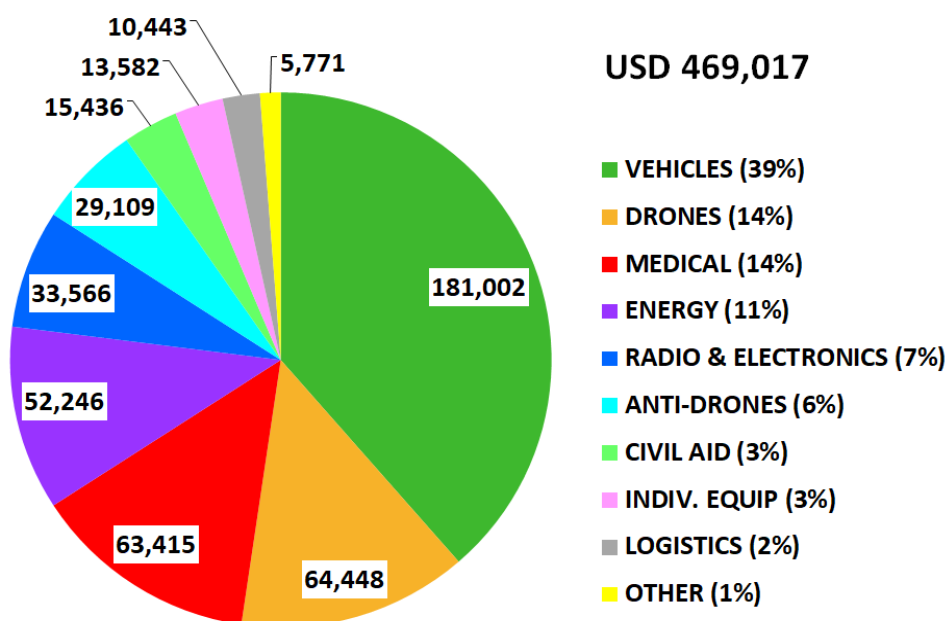




Equipment and Supplies Provided in 2025

From the first weeks of the invasion, Assist Ukraine has cared for orphaned children and provided radios, drones, anti-drone devices, 4x4 vehicles, ambulances, generators, power stations, medical supplies, survival gear, and other critically-needed things that save lives. In 2025, we scoured western Europe for vehicles that we could purchase, repair, and equip for more than 60 brigades that rely on our help. We continued to deliver tons of tactical medical supplies that were otherwise unavailable. The live-saving equipment and supplies we provided are summarized as follows:

Supplies & Equipment Provided, Nov. 2024 – Nov. 2025



20 vehicles, including jeeps, cars, vans, pick-up trucks, two buses, and an ambulance; as well as repairs, tires, and outfitting vehicles for rescue missions.

32 Starlink Internet Modems, some as customized automobile versions

42 High-Capacity Power Stations, 0.6 to 2.4 kWh

151 Power Banks, 30,000-518,000 mAh

10 Radio-Electronic Drone Jammers, different models and manufacturers

16 Drones (DJI Mavic 3, DJI Mavic 3PRO)

12 Thermal Vision Drones (DJI Mavic 3 Thermal, DJI Matrice 4 Thermal)

2 Thermal Anti-Shakhed planes (with thermal camera, made in Ukraine):

9 Motorola radio stations, DP4400 series:

7 Night vision monoculars: 2 professional (military), 5 amateur (digital)

80 Batteries for drones and radio stations

17 Tablets, Laptops, Computers

3 GoPro cameras for the post-flight analysis of attacks on Russian drones

1 stationary remotely controlled super-zoom camera for reconnaissance.

Anti-drone nets – 4,500 sq m (near 50,000 sq ft) to protect positions and trenches

Metal sheets and frames to build safety “cages” over vehicles.

Thermal clothes, “anti-drone” ponchos for soldiers, which conceal their thermal print, and hundreds of foot/hand warmers.

Individual protection: helmets, armored vests, plates, clothes, sleeping bags, etc.

Other: cables, antennas and other equipment for Starlink and drone systems, construction materials and tools for building trench shelters, etc.

Tactical Medical

1500 CAT-7 tourniquets and 300 Dnipro (made in Ukraine)

800 Chest seals

300 Emergency trauma dressings

40 active thermal blankets

Many evacuation stretchers, hemostatic bandages, drugs, and other vital items.

For Civilians

Air conditioning and materials to renovate a building for displaced elderly people, who have lost their home and seen loved ones killed.

Assistance to orphaned children through Ukrainian organizations.

Logistical Assistance: In 2025, Assist Ukraine helped distribute humanitarian aid provided by other international charities, including the delivery of vehicles and many tons of anti-drone nets, food, clothes, hygiene items, and medical equipment and supplies.
